- 1. Completed application form. (If handwritten, please print legibly)
- 2. Two (2) letters of recommendation from choice of high school teachers, administrators, counselors or community leaders with significant knowledge of applicant's experience and involvement. (See section 18).
- 3. An official high school transcript with cumulative grade point average.
- 4. Personal Essay. In your essay, please answer the question in **Section 7**.

Deadline for the application is **Friday**, **March 22**, **2019**. All applications are **required** to be emailed as a PDF to the email address below; All school transcripts must be mail & postmarked by **March 22**, **2019** to the address below. Any application submitted after this date will not be considered.
